Thank you for your interest in the TRIO/SSS program. TRIO/SSS is 100% funded by the US Department of Education and is therefore **REQUIRED** to verify your income and other information listed on the application itself in order to properly determine eligibility.

In order to be eligible, you must:

Be a U.S. citizen or meet residency requirements for federal student financial assistance.

Meet federal eligibility guidelines:

- Be a first-generation college student (neither parent holds a four-year degree); or
- Meet federal income guidelines; or
- Have a qualifying documented disability

Be enrolled at UNM-Gallup.

Have an academic need

Below are the steps that **MUST BE COMPLETED** before you can use TRIO/SSS services. Steps **1** and **2** must be completed for your application to be considered:

1. Complete, sign and date the TRIO/SSS application (both sides)

2. Supply required income documentation:

- a. Did you (or your parents) file taxes for the previous year?
 - i. **No**, complete the *Income Verification Form*, certifying that no federal tax returns were filed for the previous tax year. Signatures are needed.
 - ii. **Yes**, signed copies of taxes needed

3. Upon review either an acceptance or non-acceptance letter will be sent to the address listed on
